SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In Decision No. 22640, dated July 9, 1930, this Commission granted Southern California Gas Company authority to exercise certain franchise rights in the communities of Lancaster and Palmdale, subject to certain conditions enumerated in the order.

Southern California Gas Company now advises that considerable time and work will be required in acquiring the fromchise, preparing rate schedules, making a thorough survey of the
territory, designing a system, and completing arrangements for
the supply and transportation of butane, makes it necessary to
request the Commission to extend the time from October 1, 1930,
as required under Section 4 of the conditions set forth in the
order, to December 1, 1930, to begin the service of gas to the
residents within the communities of Lancaster and Palmdale.

ORDER

Southern California Gas Company, having asked permission for an extension of time within which to comply with that portion of Decision No. 22640, relative to the commencement of the service of gas in the communities of Lancaster and Palmdale, as set forth in Section 4 of the conditions; Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 22640, dated July 9, 1930, be and same is hereby modified to the extent that the date of October 1, 1930, as appears in Section 4 of the conditions be changed to read "December 1, 1930."

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 22640, dated July 9, 1930, shall remain in full force and effect.
