Railway Express Agency, Inc., a corporation, filed the above entitled application with the Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at the station of Engels, Plumas County, California. Indian Valley Railroad Company has been authorized, by Decision No. 22679 in Application No. 16723, to abandon its agency at this station and as the agency at the present time is conducted under the so-called joint agency plan whereby the agent of the railroad company also acts as the agent for the express company in the conduct of its business, applicant alleges that it becomes necessary for it to seek like authority. Applicant further alleges that, after investigation, it has found no outside party available to handle the agency.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Railway Express Agency, Inc., a corporation, to abandon its agency at the station of Engels, on the Indian Valley Railroad, in the County of Plumas, State of California, and to eliminate said agency name from its station records.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
