ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight shed and platform at its non-agency station of Almond on its Santa Ana Branch, Los Angeles Division in Orange County, erroneously stated in the application as "Los Angeles County," and shown in yellow on a blue print map (Los Angeles Division Drawing No. F-9875) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no freight business was transacted at said station during the annual period ending March 31, 1930; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said freight shed and platform is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a

corporation, to abandon and remove a freight shed and platform at its non-agency station of Almond, located on the Santa Ana Branch of its Los Angeles Division in Orange County and as shown in yellow on blue print map (Los Angeles Division Drawing No. F-9875) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
