BEFORE THE RAILFOAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SANTA BARBARA TELEPHONE COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to increase rates.

Application No. 16115.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 21979 ordered that Santa Barbara Telephone Company might make effective in its Guadalupe exchange the present rates for business service plus fifty (50) cents per month per primary telephone station and the present rates for residence service plus twenty-five (25) cents per month per primary telephone station, after a showing that it had replaced its Guadalupe manual magneto system with an Automatic dial system and continuous service, and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission has evidence that Santa Barbara Telephone Company has complied with the order in Decision No. 21979, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Santa Barbara Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to publish, file and make effective as of Soptember 1, 1930, the rates authorized

in Decision No. 21979, provided that said rates be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before August 25, 1930. For all other purposes the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date, hereof. Dated at San Francisco, California, this 134 day of August, 1930.
