ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at the station of Pinedale Junction on its Clovis Branch, San Joaquin Division in Fresno County, California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business and fifty-six dollars (\$56.00) of freight business was transacted at the agency at the station of Pinedale Junction during the annual period ending April 30, 1930; that the abandonment of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said agency is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has informed the Commission by letter of July 30, 1930, that it does not oppose the granting of this application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency at the station of Pinedale Junction located on the Clovis Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Fresno County and to eliminate said agency name from its station records.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
