O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight platform located at its non-agency station of Teague on its Covina Line in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (C.E.H. 12589) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no freight business was transacted at the non-agency station of Teague during the biennial period ending December 31, 1929, and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the freight platform is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be, and it is, hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove a freight platform located at its

non-agency station of Teague, on its Covina Line, in Los Angeles County, and as shown in yellow on blue-print map (C.E.H. 12589) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
