In the Matter of the Application of Sacramento Northern Railroad for permission to construct a system of tracks at grade connecting its existing tracks on "I" Street in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, with the Union Electric Railroad Passenger Station to be located on the north half of the block bounded by Eleventh, Twelfth, "H" and "I" Street, in said City.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Sacramento Northern Railway having asked for permission to remove certain wigwags in the City of Sacramento, an investigation having been made by the Commission's Engineering Department and the City of Sacramento having expressed its approval of the proposed changes,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and the same is hereby granted to Sacramento Northern Railway to remove its Standard No. 4 wigwags located at the following crossings in the City of Sacramento:

<u>Crossing No.</u>	<u>Location</u>
8-93.94	N.W. corner Twelfth & "I" Streets.
8-93.70	N.E. corner Eleventh & "I" Streets.

The authority herein granted is subject to the condition that a speed restriction of five (5) miles per hour for

eastbound trains around the curve at the northwest corner of Twelfth and "I" Streets be made effective.

The Commission shall be notified, within thirty (30) days thereafter, of the removal of the above wigwags.

If said wigwags shall not have been removed within one (1) year from the date of this order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
