ORDER

The People of the State of California on relation of the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the 3rd day of September, 1930, asking for authority to reconstruct a state highway at undergrade under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the vicinity of the City of Santa Barbara as hereinafter set forth. Applicant alleges that an agreement has been reached with said Southern Pacific Company on the allocation of costs of the proposed alteration, and it appears to this Commission that the present proceeding is not one in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted, subject to the conditions hereinafter specified, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the People of the State of California on relation of the Department of Public Works, Division of

Highways, to alter and reconstruct state highway known as Road V-S.B.-2-K at undergrade under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company at the location near Santa Barbara, Santa Barbara County, and as shown by the map (Exhibit "A") attached to the application.

The above crossing is identified as Crossing No. E-365.7-B.

Said crossing shall be altered and reconstructed subject to the following conditions and not otherwise:

(1) Said undergrade crossing shall be altered and reconstructed in accordance with the provisions of this Commission's General Orders No. 26-C and No. 64-A.

(2) The cost of alteration and reconstruction and maintenance of said undergrade crossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement or agreements to be hereinafter entered into by the interested parties, fully executed copy or copies of said agreement or agreements shall be filed with this Commission for its approval within ninety (90) days from the date hereof. In the event an agreement cannot be reached by the interested parties, this Commission will apportion costs of reconstruction and maintenance by subsequent order.

(3) Applicant shall, before commencement of reconstruction, file with this Commission a complete set of detailed plans of the proposed reconstruction. Said detailed plans are to be approved by Southern Pacific Company.

(4) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the reconstruction of said undergrade crossing.

(5) If said undergrade crossing shall not have been reconstructed within one year from the date of this order, the

authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
