FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, by Decision No. 17149 of July 27, 1926,  
on Application No. 13018, Joe Mattos was authorized to acquire  
from C.E. Smith an operating right for an automobile service  
for the transportation of passengers and freight between Truckee  
and Sierraville, and

Whereas, under date of September 17, 1930, Joe Mattos  
has informed the Commission, in writing, that he is unable to  
continue the operation because of the entire absence of demand  
on the part of the public for the transportation of passengers  
and property between Truckee and Sierraville, now

Therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Joe Mattos be and he hereby is  
authorized to discontinue and abandon all service between Truckee  
and Sierraville, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate herein-  
before referred to be and it hereby is revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs and time  
schedules of Joe Mattos on file with the Commission be and they  
are hereby cancelled.
