OPINION and ORDER

This proceeding is an application by Pacific Greyhound
 Lines, Inc., for an order of the Railroad Commission author-
 izing:

- 1- Abandonment of operating rights and routes between
 Seal Beach and Santa Ana.
- 2- Extension of its operations between Riverside and
 San Bernardino.
- 3- Abandonment of route between Riverside and Beaumont,
 via Moreno, so as to permit performance of all service
 between Riverside and Beaumont via Redlands.
- 4- Change of route between Los Angeles and Long Beach.

A public hearing in the matter was held by Examiner Williams
 at Los Angeles, testimony taken and an order of submission made.

Prior to the filing of the application herein, Pacific
 Greyhound Lines, Inc., had filed with the Commission an appli-
 cation (No. 16642), for an "in lieu" certificate covering all
 its operations south and east of Los Angeles, including the
 territory and the points affected by the proposal herein. By
 Decision No. 22905, dated September 26, 1930, and issued on said

Application No.16642, the Commission granted said in lieu certificate, said certificate, among other matters, authorizing the extension, abandonments and rerouting proposed herein. An order of dismissal should, therefore, be entered in this proceeding.

O R D E R

This matter having been heard and submitted, and the Commission being fully advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be, and the same is hereby dismissed.
