OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

George W. Koenig applicant herein under the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 15285 of August 13, 1925 on Application No. 11562 was authorized to acquire from Seth U. Bergevin an operating right for the transportation of passengers and freight between Markleeville and Fredericksburg. The service heretofore performed has been daily except Sunday throughout the year.

In this application applicant Koenig has petitioned the Commission for authority to reduce his daily except Sunday service during the period from approximately October 1 of each year to approximately June 15 of the succeeding year to an "on call" service. As justification for such petition the application alleges that there is insufficient traffic offered him to make his operations profitable during the winter season.

In view of the reasons set forth in the application herein the Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant George W. Koenig

be and he hereby is authorized to perform on "on call" service seasonally between approximately October 1 of each year and June 15 of each succeeding year in conjunction with and as a part of the operating right hereinbefore referred to.
