FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 22945 dated the 7th day of October, 1930, having authorized the California Water Service Company to purchase and acquire the water system owned and/or controlled by E.J. Whitney, Harry L. Person, Carl W. Faucett and Anna L. Welcher, supplying water to consumers in the so-called Maravilla Tract or Tract No. 4824, Los Angeles County, and said California Water Service Company having requested this Commission for authority to place in effect in said tract the same rules and regulations and the same schedule of rates as are now effective throughout its Belvedere water system, and it appearing that this request will amount to a reduction in the rates heretofore charged in the Maravilla Tract and should therefore be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that California Water Service Company be and it is hereby authorized and directed to place in effect on the first day of November, 1930, in Tract No. 4824, Los

Angeles County, the rules and regulations and the schedule of rates now effective on its Belvedere water system.
