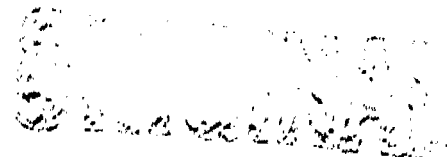


Decision No. 22005.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Abandonment of Street Car Service on Tenth Street from Market Street to Harrison Street, in the City and County of San Francisco.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Application having been made by Market Street Railway Company, a public utility corporation, for authority to abandon service upon a portion of one of its street railway lines in the City and County of San Francisco, to-wit: that on Tenth Street between Market and Harrison Streets, the matter having been considered by the Commission, and it appearing that this is not a matter as to which a public hearing is required,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Market Street Railway Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized, as requested in the above numbered and entitled application, to abandon public utility street railway service over that portion of its street railway lines in the City and County of San Francisco situated on Tenth Street between Market and Harrison Streets in said City and County, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that authority is hereby granted to said Market Street Railway Company to remove its

tracks from said portion of its lines.
