ORDER APPROVING WHARF FRANCHISE

Rodeo Vallejo Ferry Company, a California corporation, seeks an order approving the action of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa in granting a wharf franchise upon the following described lands;

That certain overflowed and submerged land belonging to the State of California bordering on the southern shore of the Bay of San Pablo, a navigable arm of the sea in Township (10) Supervisor District No. One of the County of Contra Costa, State of California, and being within the following boundaries; Beginning at a point on the northern boundary line of the right of way of the Northern Railway Co., now owned by the Southern Pacific Co., near Lone Tree Point, distant fifteen hundred (1500) feet southwesterly from the northeast corner of land formerly belonging to the Union Stock Yard Company, thence N. 20° 10° W. (Magnetic Meridian) to four fathom depth of water at ordinary low tide; thence southwesterly along the four fathom line aforesaid one thousand (1000) feet to station; thence S. 20° 10° E. to the line of ordinary high water on the southern shore of the Bay of San Pablo, thence northeasterly and southeasterly zlong the line of ordinary high water aforesaid into the point of beginning.

The application to the Board of Supervisors and various orders issued by that body, as well as applicant's amended articles of incorporation, have been filed herein. Section 2906 of the Political Code provides that such franchises may be granted "upon approval of the railroad commission." It appears that this is not a matter requiring a public hearing and approval of such where franchise is hereby granted.
