FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Lemen has advised the Commission, in writing, that on July 1, 1930, he discontinued operation of an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and property between Paso Robles and Adelaída and Elau he was authorized to perform under a certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by him from L. Hardie by Decision No. 13213, issued on Application No. 13645, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the operating rights acquired by J. W. Lemen under said Decision No. 13213 be and the same are hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by J. W. Lemen covering said service between Paso Robles and Adelaída and Elau be and the same are hereby canceled.
