FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant, on October 27, 1930, requested permission to remove the passenger station from Barrett to Incline on its line, alleging that the railroad business at Barrett could be conducted as a non-agency station, as authorized by the Commission's Decision No. 19365, dated February 15, 1928, in this proceeding, without the passenger station building, provided the freight shed and platform remained intact at Barrett to serve the freight and express business at this point.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that applicant's request is reasonable and should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Yosemite Valley Railroad Company is hereby authorized to move its passenger station building from Barrett to Incline on its line in Mariposa County.

In all other respects the Commission's decision heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
