THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In its Decision No. 22640, dated July 9, 1930, this Commission made its order granting certain certification and authorization to Southern California Gas Company subject to certain conditions, among which was the following:

"6. That Southern California Gas Company shall file with this Commission, on or before August 31, 1930, a stipulation, duly executed upon the authority of its Board of Directors, agreeing that if and when, at any time, this Commission desires to investigate any of the costs or revenues incident to this service, including the costs of liquid gas, applicant will produce and present to the Commission, at the latter's request, all of the details that make up such costs or revenue, including a break-down of the production costs which make up the contract price for the purchase of such liquid gas."

The time limit for compliance with this Condition 6 was, by Decision No. 22914, dated September 26, 1930, extended to November 1, 1930.

Upon further careful consideration of this Condition 6, the Commission is of the opinion that it should be eliminated from the order in said Decision No. 22640, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 22640, dated July 9, 1930, and amended by Decision No. 22914, dated September 26, 1930, be and the same is hereby further amended to exclude said Condition 6.

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 22640 and amended by Decision No. 22914 shall remain in full force and effect.
