FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, A. W. Bedwell, engaged in the business of transporting freight between Independence and Kearsarge has petitioned the Commission for authority to discontinue the service and for an order revoking and annulling the operating right under which said service has been performed, and

WHEREAS, said A.W.Bedwell, in support of said petition, has filed a statement showing that from January, 1930, to October 1, 1930, his revenue from the transportation of freight totaled \$87.06 as against operating expenses of \$203.67, a loss of \$116.61, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A.W.Bedwell be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue operation of trucking service he was authorized to perform between Independence and Kearsarge by Railroad Commission Decision No.14740, dated April 4, 1925, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said A.W.Bedwell by said Decision No.14740 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by said A.W. Bedwell covering said service be and the same are hereby canceled.
