FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant filed a supplemental application in the above entitled proceeding on October 24th, 1930, asking that the Commission issue an amending order to its Decision No. 22765, dated August 7th, 1930, in the above entitled proceeding, amplifying as to how all of the operative property of the Mt. Tamalpais and Muir Woods Railway should be disposed of.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and applicant's request is reasonable; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in said Decision No. 22765 be modified by striking out the words "and to quitclaim its rights of way to the original grantors or their successors" and substituting therefor the following "and dispose of all its operative property in a legal manner."

In all other respects said Decision No. 22765 shall remain in full force and effect.
