BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Sunset Railway Company, a corporation, on November 7, 1930, applied for authority to abandon a passenger shelter shed at its non-agency station of Kyan, in Kern County, and shown in yellow on a blue print map attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at said non-agency station during the year ending August 31, 1930, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of said shelter shed is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sunset Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon a passenger shelter shed located at Kyan, in Kern County, State of California.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter,

notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
