## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The City of Vallejo having on November 21, 1930, filed its Supplemental Application herein requesting a modification of Condition No. 1 of the Commission's Decision No. 23051 in the above entitled application and it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that said Supplemental Application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No. 1 of Decision No. 23051, dated November 6, 1930, is hereby smended to read as follows:

"(1) The entire expense of constructing the crossing shall be borne by applicant. The cost of maintenance of that portion of said crossing up to lines two (2) feet outside of the outside rails shall be borne by applicant. The maintenance of that portion of the crossing between lines two (2) feet outside of the outside rails shall be borne by Southern Pacific Company. Southern Pacific Company shall perform all actual work of constructing the crossing between lines two (2) feet outside of the outside rails."

In all other respects Decision No. 23051 shall remain in full force and effect.
