SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In its Decisions No. 22564, dated June 23, 1930, and No. 22805, dated August 23, 1930, on the above numbered application, this Commission made its order declaring that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise of the rights and privileges granted under franchises which applicant, Natural Gas Corporation of California, possesses or contemplates securing and the construction by applicant of plants and systems in certain enumerated communities, the certification and authorization therein granted being subject to the conditions set forth therein.

In this application, applicant asks the Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, authorizing it to exercise the right and privileges under franchise which it contemplated procuring from San Bernardino County for the purpose of supplying gas service in the community of Barstow and for

authority to install plant and distribute liquefied natural gas therein.

Applicant now no longer contemplates service in Barstow, and on November 6, 1930, requested the dismissal of this application in so far as it applies to the community of Barstow.

Natural Gas Corporation of California, having now complied with all of the conditions set forth in the Commission's Decisions No. 22564, dated June 23, 1930, and No. 22805, dated August 23, 1930, in so far as they apply to the service of gas to the communities specifically set forth in the following order;

The Railroad Commission of the State of California, hereby orders that a certificate of public convenience be and the same is hereby granted to Natural Gas Corporation of California, authorizing applicant to construct and operate plants and systems for the service of mixed liquefied natural hydrocarbon gas of Five Hundred Fifty (550) British thermal unit quality in the following cities, towns and communities, and the exercise by applicant of the rights and privileges granted by the franchises enumerated below, in so far as the exercise of such rights are necessary for the service to said communities:
