LOUETTE, COMMISSIONER:

O P I N I O N

In this proceeding Public Utilities California Corporation, a California corporation, engaged in the distribution of electric energy in and about Crescent City and Smith River, in the County of Del Norte, State of California, and in other localities in said State, asks that the Railroad Commission of the State of California make its order and decision authorizing applicant to withdraw and cancel certain filed and unfiled schedules covering the service of electricity in and adjacent to the communities of Crescent City and Smith River, and to file and make effective in lieu thereof certain revised schedules.

The filed schedules now in effect which applicant seeks to withdraw and cancel are as follows:

Crescent City and adjacent territory:

Schedule I-1 General Lighting Service.
 Schedule C-1 General Heating and Cooking Service.
 Schedule D-1 Combination Domestic, Lighting, Heating and Cooking Service.
 Schedule P-1 General Power Service.
 Schedule B Municipal and County Street Lighting Service.

The unfiled schedules now in effect which applicant seeks to cancel are as follows:

Smith River and adjacent territory:

Schedule I-2 General Lighting Service.
 Schedule C-2 General Heating and Cooking Service.
 Schedule D-2 Combination Domestic, Lighting, Heating and Cooking Service.
 Schedule P-2 General Power Service.

Applicant alleges that the proposed schedules which it seeks authorization to file and make effective in lieu of the above schedules and which are set forth under Exhibits "A" and "B" of the application will result in a substantial reduction in rates to applicant's consumers in the territory involved, although in a few cases consumers' bills will be slightly increased.

A public hearing was held in this application at Crescent City before Commissioner Louttit on December 3, 1930, at which time and place evidence and testimony were introduced relative to the rates in question.

From a study of such evidence and testimony, this Commission is of the opinion that applicant should be authorized to withdraw and cancel the aforementioned present schedules and to file and make effective in lieu thereof certain revised schedules.

I recommend the following form of order:

ORDER

Public Utilities California Corporation having asked

that the Railroad Commission of the State of California make its order and decision authorizing applicant to withdraw and cancel those certain schedules covering the service of electricity in and adjacent to the communities of Crescent City and Smith River, County of Del Norte, all as set forth in the above opinion, and to file and make effective in lieu thereof certain revised schedules, a public hearing having been held, the matter being submitted and now ready for decision,

The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby orders that Public Utilities California Corporation be and the same is authorized:

- (1) To withdraw and cancel its present Schedules L-1, C-1, D-1, P-1 and B applicable to the service of electricity in the community of Crescent City and adjacent territory, and to file and make effective in lieu thereof, for all meter readings taken on and after January 1, 1931, Schedules L-1, C-1, D-1, P-1 and L-3, as set forth in Exhibit "A" of this order.
- (2) To withdraw and cancel its present Schedules L-2, C-2, D-2 and P-2, applicable to the service of electricity in the community of Smith River and adjacent territory, and to file and make effective in lieu thereof, for all meter readings taken on and after January 1, 1931, Schedules L-2, C-2, D-2 and P-2, as set forth in Exhibit "B" of this order.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.

The foregoing opinion and order are hereby approved and ordered filed as the opinion and order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
