BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the Application of San Francisco, Napa and Calistoga Railway to sell certain real property detached from its right of way within County of Napa, State of California.

O R D E R

San Francisco, Napa and Calistoga Railway, a corporation, on December 1, 1930, applied for authority to sell a certain parcel of operative property, located in the County of Napa, State of California, to Napa Union High School for the sum of Six Hundred (600.00) Dollars. Applicant alleges that said property is no longer necessary for the operation of its railroad.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted, subject to certain conditions;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Francisco, Napa and Calistoga Railway is hereby authorized to sell to Napa Union High School that certain parcel of property in the County of Napa, State of California, and described in the application, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a determination of the value of the property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

(3) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
