ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This proceeding is a formal complaint filed by the County of Kings, complainant, through Mr. J. J. Deuel, Manager of the Law and Utilities Department of the California Farm Bureau Federation, under date of September 17, 1930, against Southern California Gas Company, defendant, wherein it is alleged that the rates and charges assessed and exacted by defendant, of and from its said consumers within the County of Kings for supplying them with gas, are unjust and unreasonable and therefore unlawful.

Subsequently, under date of December 16, 1930, after defendant had filed reduced gas rates in the territory involved which were satisfactory to complainant, complainant requested by letter to this Commission that this complaint against Southern California Gas Company be dismissed and, therefore,

good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled formal complaint be and it is hereby dismissed.
