OPINION and ORDER  
ON  
SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION

This is a supplemental application in the above entitled proceeding for an order of the Railroad Commission authorizing applicant herein to re-route service authorized by Decision No. 23053.

It is not proposed to change the fares now in effect, and the change proposed has the approval of the Board of Public Utilities and Transportation of the City of Los Angeles, as is indicated by a copy of a letter from the board attached to the application. The proposed change, it is claimed, will enable applicant to give better service to the students attending the University of California at Los Angeles.

We are of the opinion that this application should be granted. It does not appear to be a matter in which a public hearing is necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to re-route the service it was authorized to perform by Decision No. 23053 and to operate over and along the following route:

Commencing at intersection of Highland Avenue and Selma Avenue, east on Selma Avenue to Mc Cadden Place, north on Mc Cadden Place to Hollywood Boulevard, west on Hollywood Boulevard to Highland Avenue, south on Highland Avenue to Santa Monica Boulevard, west on Santa Monica Boulevard to Crescent Heights Boulevard, thence north on Crescent Heights Boulevard to Sunset Boulevard.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company shall file time schedules covering service over the new route herein authorized, said schedules to be satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
