<p>In the matter of application of SUNSET RAILWAY COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of two spur tracks at Maricopa station in the County of Kern, State of California.</p>

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Sunset Railway Company, a corporation, on December 22, 1930, applied for authority to abandon and remove two spur tracks located at Maricopa in Kern County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said tracks are owned by it and were constructed in 1904; that subsequent to the construction of said spur tracks they were used for the receipt and delivery of freight but said spur tracks have not been used for receipt or delivery of freight for the past several years and that said spur tracks are not now needed for any purpose nor likely to be needed in the future.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sunset Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove two spur tracks located at Maricopa in Kern County and as more definitely shown in yellow on the map (San Joaquin Division Drawing AC-4134) attached to

the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
