<p>In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Caplin, Tulare County, State of California.</p>

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on December 19th, 1930, applied for authority to abandon and remove a passenger shelter shed, located at Caplin in Tulare County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at said station of Caplin during the year ending September 30th, 1930, and that said passenger shelter shed is not now being used and has not been used for more than a year and it is not likely to be required in the future.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove the passenger shelter shed located at Caplin, in Tulare County.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the

facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
