

Decision No. 23230

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment of non-agency station of Jacobs in the County of Tulare, State of California, and the abandonment and removal of a spur track approximately 564 feet in length located at said Jacobs Station.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on December 19, 1930, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Jacobs, located on the Visalia Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Tulare County, and to abandon and remove a spur track at said station shown in yellow on a blue print map attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that no business was transacted at said non-agency station during the year ending October 31, 1930; that said spur track has not been used for the receipt or delivery of freight for more than one year and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency and spur track is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Jacobs,

located on the Visalia Branch in Tulare County, State of California; to abandon and remove a spur track at said station, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
