In the matter of the application of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, to sell real property to the City of Beverly Hills and to relocate certain facilities thereon.

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, on December 12, 1930, filed the above entitled application, requesting authority to sell a parcel of land in the City of Beverly Hills, County of Los Angeles; to relocate and reconstruct certain station facilities and tracks in the vicinity of the parcel that it is proposed to sell; to relocate a crossing of a spur track with Third Street between Alpine Drive and Foothill Road; and, to construct a spur track across the northwest corner of Alpine Drive and Santa Monica Boulevard. It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted subject to certain conditions.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to sell to the City of Beverly Hills, in accordance with the terms of an agreement dated November 5, 1930, a copy of which is attached to the application, those certain parcels of property described therein and as shown by the map, CE 9233-a, attached to the application, subject to the following conditions:

- (4) Applicant shall remove the track shown in yellow on the map attached to the application, in so far as it lies in Third Street, and shall repair the roadway to conform to the remainder thereof.
- (5) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossings and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (6) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.
- (7) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders, relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings, as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, public convenience and necessity demand such action.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
