SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In its Decisions Nos. 23181 and 23182, dated December 15, 1930, this Commission granted to Harold G. Laub a preliminary certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require and will require the construction by applicant of a gas plant and system in Barstow and Victorville for the distribution and sale of liquified natural gas and the exercise by applicant of the rights and privileges granted under Ordinances Nos. 335 and 336 of the County of San Bernardino, in so far as such exercise is necessary for the construction of this specific project, and authorizing the construction of such

plant and system, all subject to certain conditions, among which is the following:

- "(4) That Harold G. Laub shall file with this Commission, and apply to all billing for gas in the community covered by this order, the following initial rate for general domestic and commercial gas service:

Service Charge \$1.25 per Meter per Month.

Commodity Charge (To be added to Service Charge):

First 100 Lbs. per Meter per Mo.	4¢ per Lb.
Next 400 " " " " "	3¢ " "
All Over 500 " " " " "	2.5¢ " "

After further consideration of the factors involved in the cost of this service due to recent developments and conditions, including purchase price of liquid gas, location of source of supply, transportation and other costs, this Commission is of the opinion that the rate as set forth in the above quoted condition (4) of Decisions Nos. 23181 and 23182 should be modified, therefore,

Good Cause Appearing,

The Railroad Commission of the State of California Hereby Orders and Declares that its Decisions Nos. 23181 and 23182, dated December 15, 1930, be and the same are hereby amended so that condition (4) thereof is modified to read as follows:

- (4) That Harold C. Laub shall file with this Commission, and apply to all billing for gas in the community covered by this order, the following initial rate for general domestic and commercial gas service:

Service Charge \$1.00 per Meter per Month.

Commodity Charge (To be added to Service Charge):

First 100 Lbs. per Meter per Mo.	5¢ per Lb.
Next 400 " " " " "	4¢ " "
All Over 500 " " " " "	3¢ " "

In all other respects Decisions Nos. 23181 and 23182

shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be from and after the date hereof.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
