FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Orin Scranton, who acquired under authority of Railroad Commission Decision No. 20250 a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport eggs and poultry feed and poultry supplies between Los Angeles and points in the vicinity of San Jacinto has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of December 15, 1930, that because the Poultrymens Co-operative Association of San Jacinto has installed a fleet of trucks and is now doing its own hauling, there is no further need for the service performed by him, and

WHEREAS, said Orin Scranton has requested that the certificate acquired by him under Decision No. 20250 be revoked and annulled, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by said Orin Scranton under Decision No. 20250 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules covering said service filed with the Railroad Commission by said Orin Scranton be and the same are hereby canceled.
