FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Souther Warehouse Company in the above entitled matter applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to lease its warehouse located in the City of Oakland to H. L. Hinman, in accordance with the terms of an agreement of lease filed as Exhibit "A" in this proceeding; and

WHEREAS, the Commission by Decision No. 23109, dated November 24, 1930, authorized Souther Warehouse Company to execute, on or before December 31, 1930, a lease substantially in the form as said lease filed as Exhibit "A", it being represented at the hearing held on the application that the lessee would not use the properties for public warehouse purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is now advised that the proposed lease will be executed by and between Souther Warehouse Company and Oakland Warehouse Terminals Co., instead of H. L. Hinman, but in substantially the same form as said Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, a request is made for an extension of time within which such lease may be executed; and
