SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND OFDER

In its Decision No. 23124, dated November 28, 1930, this Commission made its decision and order declaring that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by Santa Maria Gas Company of the rights and privileges under franchise granted to it by Ordinance No. 432 by the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County under date October 1, 1928, in so far as the exercise of such franchise is necessary to the specific project outlined in the opinion of said decision, and the construction by applicant of a plant and system for the manufacture and distribution of hydrocarbon gas in the community of Solvang, Santa Barbara County, such certification and authorization being subject to the following Conditions:

(1) That Santa Maria Gas Company shall file with this Commission, on or before March 1, 1931, a stipulation duly executed upon authority of its Board of Directors, agreeing that applicant, its successors or assigns will never claim before the Railroad Commission or other public body or court, a value for the franchise granted by Ordinance No. 432, passed by the Board
