The necessary franchise or permit (Ordinance No. 8810 N.S.) has been granted by the Board of Supervisors of said City and County for the construction of said crossings at grade and applicant has filed with the Commission a copy of a letter from the Market Street Railway Company agreeing to the installation of a crossing with its tracks, subject to the terms of an agreement to be executed before construction is started.
