

Decision No. 23273.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment of non-agency station at Sumner, in the County of Tulare, State of California and the abandonment and removal of a spur track approximately 1200 feet in length at said station.

**ORDER**

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on December 26, 1930, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Sumner in Tulare County and to abandon and remove a spur track at said station.

Applicant alleges that no business was transacted at said non-agency station or on said spur track during the year ending September 30, 1930; that said track was constructed for the Associated Pipe Line Company in 1906, is no longer used by said company and said company has consented to the removal of said track and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station and facilities is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Sumner in Tulare County, State of California; to abandon and remove a spur track at said station; to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying

at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
