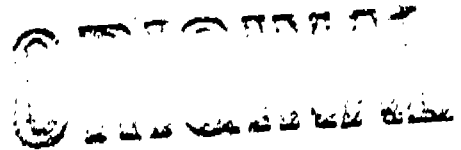


DECISION NO. 23304.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this application Pacific Gas and Electric Company asks that the Railroad Commission of the State of California make its decision and order increasing the electric rate under applicant's Schedule P-6 - Resale Power Service. In view of the fact that this schedule and all of applicant's other electric schedules are interim rates, filed in accordance with this Commission's Decision No. 22031 dated January 15, 1930, it is the opinion of the Commission that this application should be dismissed without prejudice; therefore, good cause appearing,
