BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on January 17, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a freight platform at Adobe Station on its Springville Branch in Tulare County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said freight platform has not been used for the past several years and that said platform is not now needed nor, in applicant's opinion, likely to be needed in the future.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove a freight platform at Adobe Station, located on its Springville Branch in Tulare County.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter,

notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
