FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

The County of Los Angeles, applicant herein, having on December 11, 1930, requested that Condition (2) of Decision No. 23093, dated November 18, 1930, be modified by striking out the words "shown as Standard No. 4 in our General Order No. 72;" and inserting the words "shown as Standard No. 2 in our General Order No. 72;" in lieu thereof and it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that said request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (2) of Decision No. 23093 be amended by striking out the words "shown as Standard No. 4 in our General Order No. 72;" and inserting in

lieu thereof "shown as Standard No. 2 in our General Order No. 72;"

In all other respects Decision No. 23093 shall remain in full force and effect.
