FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Mrs. A. R. Jeffery and James A. Goss, who acquired the Jeffery mail contract, have further advised that the service has been abandoned, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to A.R. Jeffery by said Decision No. 12093 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by said A.R. Jeffery be and the same are hereby canceled.
