FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL  
OPINION and ORDER

Whereas the Commission by its Decision No. 23255 on  
 Application No. 16769 granted a certificate to Joe Dellera between  
 Reno Junction and Downieville and intermediate points, and

Whereas Joe Dellera in a letter dated January 15, 1931  
 states that the United States mail is no longer delivered to him  
 at Reno Junction but instead at Chilcoot and therein requests  
 authority to terminate his operations at Chilcoot instead of Reno  
 Junction, now

Therefore, good cause appearing therein

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that that portion of Decision No. 23255  
 reading

"THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA  
 Hereby declares that public convenience and necessity  
 require the operation by Joe Dellera of an automobile  
 service as a common carrier of passengers and freight  
 between Reno Junction and Downieville, and intermediate  
 points, via Vinton, Loyalton, Sierraville, Sattley and  
 Sierra City, and

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public con-  
 venience and necessity for such a service be and the  
 same is hereby granted to Joe Dellera, subject to the  
 following conditions:

1. That no passengers shall be transported between  
 Reno Junction and Sattley and intermediate points,  
 all inclusive."

be and it hereby is changed to read:

"THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA  
 hereby declares that public convenience and necessity  
 require the operation by Joe Dellera of an automobile  
 service as a common carrier of passengers and freight

between Chilcoot and Downieville, and intermediate points, via Vinton, Loyalton, Sierraville, Sattley and Sierra City, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity for such a service be and the same is hereby granted to Joe Dellera, subject to the following conditions:

1. That no passengers shall be transported between Chilcoot and Sattley and intermediate points, all inclusive.

In all other respects Decision No. 23255 is to remain in full force and effect.
