ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, on January 12, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a freight platform located at Gallina Station on its Los Angeles-Santa Ana Line, in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blue print map (C.E.Z. 12890) attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that on March 1, 1920, freight service from this station was discontinued; that there has been no revenue derived on shipments to or from Gallina Station during the annual period ending December 31, 1930, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the freight platform is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove a freight platform located at Gallina Station on its Los Angeles-Santa Ana Line, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment and removal of the facilities authorized herein.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void, if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
