SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 23238 herein, among other things, authorized Pacific Electric Railway Company to sell certain properties to the City of Beverly Hills in accordance with the terms of an agreement dated November 5, 1930. Upon request of the City of Beverly Hills, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that of the various conditions set forth in said Decision No. 23238 the following conditions only shall apply to the authorization therein granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company to sell such properties to the City of Beverly Hills:

(1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

(2) The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a determination of the

value of the property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

In all other respects Decision No. 23238 shall remain in full force and effect.
