FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The following order is issued pursuant to a conclusion set forth in the Opinion of the Commission's Decision No. 23312, dated January 26th, 1931, in Application No. 17013, a related application; therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 22857, dated September 12th, 1930, in this proceeding is hereby modified to provide that instead of removing the left-hand gates at Crossing No. E-16.4, Howard Avenue, four (4) crossing gates be maintained for the protection of this crossing until further order of the Commission.

In all other respects said Decision No. 22857 shall remain in full force and effect.
