SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, this Commission by Decision No. 21641, dated October 3, 1929 on Application No. 15544 granted to Foss Field and Martin Kleinfeld, copartners, a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, baggage and express between Keck's Corners, Kern County, and Hanford, King's County, and intermediate points, and

WHEREAS, said copartners in a letter dated January 24, 1931 have requested permission to temporarily suspend operations between the intermediate points of Avenal and Keck's Corner until July 31, 1931,

Therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Foss Field and Martin Kleinfeld, copartners, be and they are hereby authorized to temporarily suspend service between the intermediate points of Avenal and Keck's Corners until July 31, 1931 subject to the condition:

That Field and Kleinfeld immediately file a new time schedule giving effect to the temporary suspension herein authorized.
