O R D E R

Sunset Railway Company, a corporation, on February 2nd, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a spur track located at Fellows on the main line in Kern County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said track is owned by it and that the track was constructed in 1908 to serve the public; that said spur track has not been used for the receipt or delivery of freight or passengers for the past several years; and that said spur track is no longer required nor likely to be required in the future.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sunset Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its spur track, located at Fellows, on the main line in Kern County and as more definitely shown in yellow on the map (San Joaquin Division Drawing No. AB 3965) attached to the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the

facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
