SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In its Decisions No. 23181 and No. 23182, dated December 15, 1930, this Commission granted to Harold G. Laub a preliminary certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require and will require the construction by applicant of a gas plant and system in Barstow and Victorville for the distribution and sale of liquefied natural gas and the exercise by applicant of the rights and privileges granted under Ordinances Nos. 335 and 336 of the County of San Bernardino, in so far as such exercise is necessary for the construction of this specific project, and authorizing the construction of such plant and system, all subject to certain

conditions, among which is the following:

- (5) That Harold G. Laub shall, on or before March 1, 1931, begin the service of gas covered by this order.

After further consideration of the circumstances surrounding the construction of a gas plant and institution of service, together with the request by applicant that additional time be allowed for beginning the said service, the Commission is of the opinion that Condition (5) of Decisions No. 23181 and No. 23182 should be modified, therefore,

Good Cause Appearing,

The Railroad Commission of the State of California

Hereby Orders and Declares that its Decisions Nos. 23181 and 23182, dated December 15, 1930, be and the same are hereby amended so that Condition (5) thereof is modified to read as follows:

- (5) That Harold G. Laub shall, on or before April 1, 1931, begin the service of gas covered by this order.

In all other respects Decisions No. 23181 and No. 23182 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be from and after the date hereof.
