ORDER GRANTING CONSENT
TO EXTEND TERM OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

Southern California Gas Company, a corporation, has asked the Commission to consent to the extension of its corporate existence from October 5, 1960 up to and until midnight of February 15, 1981. It appears that the Board of Directors of said Southern California Gas Company has determined that it is for the best interests of the corporation that its term of existence be extended for such a period. The consent of this Commission to such extension is required under Section seven of Article twelve of the constitution of this state.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and is of the opinion that this is not a matter on which a public hearing is necessary and that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA that consent be and is hereby given to Southern California Gas Company to extend the term of its corporate existence up to and until midnight of the fifteenth day of February, 1931.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company shall within sixty days after the date hereof file with the Commission a certified copy of a certificate showing that the corporate existence of said Southern California Gas Company has been extended.
