BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on January 2, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a passenger shelter shed at Oban Station, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said passenger shelter shed is no longer required nor likely to be required in the future.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove a passenger shelter shed at Oban Station in Los Angeles County and as more definitely shown in yellow on the map (Drawing A-3967) attached to the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become

void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
