In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight station building at Pinedale Junction, County of Fresno, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on February 9, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a freight station building at Pinedale Junction, County of Fresno, State of California.

Applicant alleges that it maintains a freight station building which is not now required nor, in the opinion of applicant likely to be required in the future; and that the revenue derived at said station does not warrant the continued maintenance of said building.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove a freight station at Pinedale Junction, County of Fresno, State of California.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the

facilities authorized herein.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
